8 months, 50% American and 50% French oak

About The Wine

- Grapes picked at the peak of ripeness in early morning hours to preserve maximum fruit
- Fruit is de-stemmed, crushed and cold soaked for 24-48 hrs for optimal color extraction followed by malolactic fermentation
- Boysenberry, vanilla and dark chocolate aromas lead way to rich flavors of ripe black cherry with hints of crème brûlée sugar crust and butter scotch through the palate
