APPELLATION PESSAC-LÉOGNAN CONTRÔLÉE

Château COUCHEROY is a small estate located in the PESSAC-LÉOGNAN region of the GRAVES. Its history can be traced back for many centuries, and its name derives from a phrase in the Gascon dialect meaning "the king slept here". The vineyard, now owned and run by **André Lurton**, is planted with both red and white varieties on excellent gravelly soils.

This red wine, a blend of **50% Cabernet Sauvignon**, and **50% Merlot**, is aged for one year in oak barrels (25-30% new each year) and bottled fairly early to preserve its fruit and charm. The wine is medium to full bodied, with flavors of currant, plum and licorice accented by notes of oak and minerals. Serve with hearty stews, roast meats, and rich cheeses.

Recommending serving temperature : 62° - 65°F.
