PESSAC-LÉOGNAN

APPELLATION PESSAC-LÉOGNAN CONTRÔLÉE

Château COUCHEROY is a small estate located in the PESSAC-LÉOGNAN region of GRAVES. Its history can be traced back for many centuries, and its name derives from a phrase in the Gascon dialect meaning "the king slept here". The vineyard, now owned and run by **André Lurton**, is planted with both red and white varieties on excellent gravelly soils.

This white wine, from **100% Sauvignon**, is vinified partly in stainless steel and partly in barrique, and it is given six months aging sur lie before bottling. The wine is fresh and crisp, with a light touch of oak and appetizing mineral flavors typical of its vineyard. Serve with lightly sauced seafood preparations, pasta, or simple roast chicken.

Recommending serving temperature : 50° - 55°F.
