

# Château Couhins-Lurton

GRAND VIN DE BORDEAUX

Following a dramatic history spanning four centuries, the owners of Château Couhins had planned in 1967 to change its course forever by destroying its vines. Learning of their intentions a young **André Lurton** offered to lease the vineyard and continue making the wines. From tenant farmer to owner, André Lurton's commitment to this great estate is resolute. The first official recognition for the wines came in 1895 when a Silver Medal was awarded at the Great Bordeaux Exhibition. Although the property is now best known for its exceptional white wines, André Lurton has restored the red winemaking tradition by planting plots of **MERLOT (70%)** and **CABERNET SAUVIGNON (30%)**. Modern, temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel vats is followed by a period of 12 months' maturation in oak new barrels. The wine is **supple and concentrated**, offering hallmark characteristics of these two noble varieties. It can be enjoyed in its youth or savoured after 10-15 years in bottle.
