Unlike the vast majority of truly great Bordeaux Wines, this one is made from only one grape variety - SAUVIGNON BLANC (100%). It has been fascinating to observe the frenzy of excitement stirred up by this grape variety in recent years. Since 1982 we have been fermenting and maturing our Sauvignon Blanc exclusively in oak barrels - an old tradition that helps us delight the modern wine lover. This wine is both *rich and elegant, a perfectly balanced white* that can be enjoyed young or savoured after 5-10 years in bottle.

Following a dramatic and sometimes troubled history spanning four centuries, the owners of Château Couhins had planned in 1967 to change its course forever by destroying its vines. Learning of their intentions a young **André Lurton** offered to lease the vineyard and continue making the wines. From tenant farmer to owner, André Lurton's commitment to this great estate is resolute.
