The ancient art of blending grape varieties of different character together to create a single, harmonious wine is represented nowhere better than in the Grapes. This classic example unites the robust intensity of **CABERNET SAUVIGNON (55%)** with the simple succulence of **MERLOT (43%)**. A small proportion of **CABERNET FRANC (2%)** completes the picture. Once blended the wine is matured for 12 months prior to bottling in French oak barrels, half of which are new. The result is an elegant, finely structured red wine; the perfect match for equally fine fare such as roast lamb or a tender steak. *Château de Cruzeau* has a proud winemaking heritage that dates back to the early 18th century. Under the guidance and protection of *André Lurton*, this heritage is secured and the property continues to make wines of great character for the modern day wine lover.
