In recent years the noble Sauvignon Blanc grape has become almost synonymous with southern hemisphere winemaking, yet this wonderful variety has been growing here in the region of the Graves at Chateau de Cruzeau for generations. This classic example epitomises the fresh, elegant, aromatic personality of **Sauvignon Blanc (100%)**. Following fermentation in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats, the wine is aged on its lees for 10 months prior to bottling. The result is a delicious, finely balanced dry white wine that is wonderful as an apéritif, and the perfect match for fresh shellfish and creamy seafood sauces.

Chateau de Cruzeau has a proud winemaking heritage that dates back to the early 18<sup>th</sup> century. Under the guidance and protection of André Lurton, this heritage is secured and the property continues to make wines of great character for the modern day wine lover.

Serve lightly chilled.
