Château La Louvière has a proud winemaking history that spans more than four centuries. Since its acquisition in 1965 by André Lurton, the property has continued to champion the great traditions of the PÉSSAC-LEOGNAN region of the GRAVES, whilst embracing modern winemaking techniques and tastes.

This elegant, full-bodied red wine is a blend of **CABERNET SAUVIGNON (64%), MERLOT (30%), CABERNET FRANC (3%) and PETIT VERDOT (3%)**, aged carefully for 12 months in oak barrels prior to release. Enticing aromas of ripe currants and spice mingle with subtle vanilla notes, culminating in a rich, succulent palate of black fruit flavours.
