

CHÂTEAU LA LOUVIÈRE

Grand Vin de Graves

This elegant dry white wine is a blend of **SAUVIGNON (85%)** and **SEMILLON (15%)**, aged carefully for 12 months in oak barrels prior to release.

Ripe citrus fruit aromas mingle with subtle herbaceous notes, underpinning a rich yet crisp, lean palate. The wine is in its prime between 3 and 10 years old, but can age for up to 20 or 30 years.

Perhaps you are surprised to see a wine of such heritage bottled under a modern screwcap closure? Sadly, the joyous sound of a cork popping is not without its risks, particularly for delicate aromatic white wines. André Lurton is entirely convinced that this is the only method guaranteed to eliminate the unpleasant aromas sometimes associated with cork taint and oxidation. Thus, he guarantees this wine's freshness and vivacity, as was intended in its creation.
