Winemaking

Napa Valley's 2015 harvest offered very low yields due to the drought-like conditions throughout the growing season. Despite the below average yields, the fruit quality proved exceptional, making this a highly coveted limited release wine.

Tasting Notes

The aromatics of our 2015 Sauvignon Blanc suggest citrus, melon and exotic tropical notes. On the palate, the bright acidity is balanced by mandarin orange, kiwi, lime and a hint of honeydew melon. The wine's balance of acidity and fruit linger for a clean, crisp finish.
