- Packaging components (glass, capsules, stoppers, corks labels leather/metal/other packaging components): negotiate pricing and procure all components.
 - Works with DFWS customer service providers as need to ensure materials are consistent with marketing services departments requirements.
 - Manages requirements of new product development with creative department.
- Effectively project manage all packaging and new product initiatives. Works with Marketing to ensure artwork is delivered to vendors. Coordinates sample delivery and approval by Marketing and Production. Works with vendors to ensure all components are delivered on time to meet production.
- Coordinating with Head of Production regarding material requirements for production runs. Procure all required materials and track and monitor suppliers' on time delivery to meet Production scheduling.
- Qualify suppliers through quality standards in conjunction with Head of Production.
- Provides Marketing with on what is feasible for packaging changes during the artwork development stage.
- Optimize bid process on all Company materials in excess of \$15M and growing to achieve the lowest possible cost structure while ensuring quality
- Work with Marketing to procure POS elements.
- Review cost optimization in other spending categories such as T&E and telecom.
