BRAND OVERVIEW

Clos de los Siete is the passion project of world-famous Bordeaux winemaker and master blender, Michel Rolland. He first visited Argentina in 1988 and immediately recognized the opportunity for making world-class Bordeaux style wines there. Michel was soon joined by other Bordeaux families to develop 2,000 acres of vineyard in the Uco Valley south of Mendoza. Each partner family gives a portion of their harvest to this one single wine, Clos de los Siete, or Vineyard of the Seven, for the seven families originally involved in the project.

THE WINE

Michel Rolland uses his highly-praised blending skills to create a fruit-forward, round and velvety blend of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Petite Verdot.

THE UCO VALLEY, MENDOZA



- Clos de los Siete is set in the foothills of the Andes Mountains 3,600 ft above sea level, meaning hot days and cold nights for optimal ripening.
- The climate produces ripe grapes with great acidity – the backbone of well-balanced wines.
- Alluvial vineyard soils drain moisture away from the vines, concentrating the juice and boosting the richness of the fruit flavor.
