- Founded in 1926, today Cave de Lugny is the #1 White Burgundy producer.
- Unlike many other wines in the Mâconnais, Cave de Lugny is a cooperative of grower families, not a negociant. As a cooperative, Cave de Lugny has first access to some of the best fruit that the Mâconnais has to offer.
- Cave de Lugny controls about one third of all wine production in southern Burgundy and about half of all wine production in the Mâcon area.
- The pride of Cave de Lugny is the Les Charmes vineyard, the largest contiguous single vineyard in the region, comprised of 105 hectares of vineyard land and home to the eponymous Mâcon-Lugny Les Charmes.
- All Chardonnays are unoaked and sur-lie aged, resulting in bright floral aromas, a round mouthfeel, and complex flavor. The wines are extremely versatile and can be either enjoyed on their own or as a perfect pairing with a wide array of food.
- Cave de Lugny has strict growing standards for all of the vineyards in the cooperative. These standards of sustainability, fruit quality, and harvest timing ensure the best fruit from year to year.
- Cave de Lugny qualifies as a sustainable producer and complies with strict standards for vine treatment and wine production to ensure the best quality fruit at minimal cost to the environment.
